Local Law No. 3 of the Year 1971.

A Local Law Creating a County Legislature in lieu of the present Board of Supervisors and Reapportioning the County of Tioga.

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tioga as follows:

SECTION 1:

Effective January 1, 1972, the governing body of Tioga County shall be known as the Tioga County Legislature, which shall supersede the present Board of Supervisors and shall succeed to all the powers and duties presently vested in said Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 2:

Said Tioga County Legislature shall consist of nine members elected from five legislative districts as follows:

(At least one of whom shall reside in the Village of Owego)

SECTION 3:

Such legislators shall be elected for terms of two years each, the first such terms to commence January 1, 1972.

SECTION 4:

Town supervisors, village mayors, members of town boards, members of village boards of trustees, and all other qualified voters of the county shall be eligible to serve as county legislators.

SECTION 5:

After each succeeding decennial Federal census the County Legislature shall submit to the Supreme Court of the State of New York such revised plan of reapportionment as in its judgement may be required by virtue of changes in the relative populations of the legislative districts revealed by such census, and upon approval by said Court of a revised plan of reapportionment, shall implement the same by appropriate amendment of this Local Law subject to such referendum as may be required by law or by order of the Court.

SECTION 6:

For purposes of the nomination and election of county legislators, this Local Law shall take effect immediately; for all other purposes, it shall take effect January 1, 1972.

SECTION 7:

This Local Law shall be subject to approval by the voters of Tioga County at a referendum to be held concurrently with the general election of November 2, 1971.

Such local law was submitted to the people by reason of a (mandatory)(permissive) referendum, and received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon at the (general)(special)(annual) election held on , 19 , in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

4. (Subject to permissive referendum and final adoption because no valid petition was filed requesting referendum.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the (County)(City)(Town)(Village) of was duly passed by the on , 19 , and was (approved)(not disapproved)(repassed after disapproval) by the on , 19 . Such local law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of , 19 , in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the City of having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on , 19 , become operative.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the County of , State of New York, having been submitted to the

electors at the General Election of November _____, 19____, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
