Clinical Social Worker

The work involves responsibility for the clinical assessment and intervention of clients with social, emotional and related difficulties associated with their disability. Wide latitude is permitted in determining the scope of work to be performed within prescribed guidelines in assisting client towards improved intrapsychic and interpersonal functioning. The work is performed under the general supervision of a Program Director, Senior Clinical Social Worker or Supervising Clinical Social Worker who may define or limit the work to be performed. Employees in this class are expected to meet with professionals of agencies in or outside of the agency to obtain assistance and guidance for clients. Does related work as required.

The position(s) is located within the Mental Hygiene Department and may serve clients with mental illness and/or drug and alcohol dependency issues. Prior work experience with chemical dependent clients is preferred but not required to hold the position.

The title of Clinical Social Worker is a **competitive position**, requiring applicants to meet minimum qualifications established for the position and successfully meet civil service examination requirements. **An exam is anticipated for June 2009.** A provisional appointment may be made to this position.

Status: Provisional - pending permanent appointment from an eligible list

Range of Work Hours: Full-time; Monday – Friday; Work schedules may include some evening hours
