WATER QUALITY NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST

Date of Issue: 05/17/17; This is technical work involving responsibility for assisting the Conservation District Manager in carrying out the water quality program in the County. The incumbent performs a wide variety of duties related to water quality management on County streams and nutrient management planning on farms. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Conservation District Manager. Does related work as required.

The title of Water Quality Nutrient Management Specialist is **Competitive**, requiring applicants to meet minimum qualifications established for the position and successfully meet civil service examination requirements. **An examination is anticipated for 2018.** A provisional appointment may be made to this position. Permanent appointment will be dependent upon participation in the examination *AND* being reachable from the resulting eligible list.

- B) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university with an Associate's Degree in Natural Resource Management, Environmental Science, Agricultural Engineering, Soil and Water Science or a related field and two years of full-time paid experience or its part-time equivalent in agricultural nutrient management or water quality practices; **OR**
- C) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by limits of (A) and (B).

SPECIAL NOTE: Once hired, candidates will be expected to participate in training which leads to credentialing as a Certified Crop Advisor (CCA).
