Essential Job Duties:

- Perform ground maintenance work such as mowing, weed eating and tree/bush trimming.
- Perform cleaning and maintenance work on park restrooms, shower houses and pavilions.
- Perform cleaning and maintenance duties on Town owned vehicles, mowers, tractors and power tools.

Physical Requirements – Representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- While performing duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to walk, stand, push, pull, lift, reach with hands and arms, use hands to finger or grasp, talk and hear. The employee is frequently required to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, and sit. The employee occasionally required to crawl.
- Physical requirements of this person also require the ability to exert up to 50 pounds of force
 occasionally and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 10 pounds of force regularly to
 move objects.

Environmental Conditions

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to inside and outside environmental conditions. The employee is occasionally exposed to unpleasant tasks, potential for physical injury, extreme cold, fumes, strong odors or airborne particles and vibration. The noise level in the work environment is occasionally loud.

Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma.

Special Requirements:

Applicant must possess a valid New York State Driver License or have driving privileges in New York State at the time of the application and appointment. You must maintain a valid license and/or driving privileges continuously during employment.
