The term of appointment is dependent upon the complexity of the treatment plant operations as regulated by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) in Part 650 of the New York Code of Rule and Regulations. Upon satisfactory completion of the training and experience requirements as defined by the DEC, and receipt of the appropriate Operator Certification, the trainee receives permanent appointment as a Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator without additional examination. Work is performed under the immediate supervision of an appropriately certified operator. May exercise supervision over motor equipment operators or other subordinate employees. Does related work as required.

The title of Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator / Trainee is **Competitive**, requiring applicants to meet minimum qualifications established for the position and successfully meet civil service examination requirements. **Civil Service examinations are conducted the 3rd Thursday of every month**. Possession of the certificate at the time of appointment. Qualifications for certification vary according to the Grade of Wastewater Treatment Plant, as determined by the New York State Dept. of Environmental Conservation (DEC).
