

Maintenance Mechanic Classifications

Maintenance Mechanic I -

Performance of duties of one of the following trades on a regular basis with occasional assistance in the other trades, while working under the direct supervision of a higher level maintenance mechanic: carpentry, electrical, masonry, plumbing, welding, bridge repair or HVAC.

Maintenance Mechanic II -

Performance of duties of two of the following trades on a regular basis with moderate supervision. Provides occasional assistance in the other trades while working under the direct supervision of a higher level maintenance mechanic: carpentry, electrical, masonry, plumbing, welding, bridge repair or HVAC.

Maintenance Mechanic III -

Performance of duties of three or more of the following trades on a regular basis under minimal supervision, can handle projects independently: carpentry, electrical, masonry, plumbing, welding, bridge repair or HVAC. Performs all facets of project initiation and completion (creating materials list, purchasing, executing)
