TIOGA COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE – JULY 7, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **161 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **47 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine.** These are individuals who have had close contact (6 ft.) with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals that have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19.
- **126 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom and fever-free that meet the criteria to be released from Isolation.
- **24 Deaths**

*This is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time.
Administered tests are tracked in various ways. Test results are reported.*

Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Martha Sauerbrey reported five more airports are being added to the travel advisory project as of today: **Rochester, Niagara Falls, Elmira, Ogdensburg and Plattsburgh.**

This is in addition to the seven existing airports:

- Monday, June 29th at JFK, LaGuardia, Albany, Hancock (Syracuse), Stewart (Newburgh) and Buffalo-Niagara
- Friday, July 3rd MacArthur (Islip)

On June 25th, eight states met the criteria for required quarantine: Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas, and Utah.

As of June 30th, eight additional states were added: California, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, and Tennessee.

As of today, July 7th, three additional states were added: Delaware, Kansas, and Oklahoma
