Sample Instructions for Voting Absentee

- (1) Mark only with a pen having BLACK INK.
- (2) Mark the oval above the name of your choice.
- (3) To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name clearly in the box labeled "Write-in," staying within the box. Any mark or writing, outside the spaces provided for voting, may void the entire ballot.
- (4) The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
- (5) You have a right to a replacement ballot. If you make a mistake or want to change your vote, call the Board of Elections at 607-687-8261 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.
- (6) After completing your ballot, insert it into the OFFICIAL ENVELOPE provided, seal and sign.
- (7) Return your ballot to the Tioga County Board of Elections by following the instructions printed on the official Return Envelope.

Sample Instructions for Voting at Your Poll Site

- (1) Mark only with a writing instrument provided by the Board of Elections.
- (2) Mark the oval above the name of your choice.
- (3) To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name clearly in the box labeled "Write-in," staying within the box. Any mark or writing, outside the spaces provided for voting, may void the entire ballot.
- (4) The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
- (5) If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, ask a poll worker for a new ballot.
- (6) After completing your ballot, insert it into the ballot scanner and wait for the notice that your ballot has been successfully scanned. If no such notice appears, seek the assistance of an election inspector.
