- Overdoses are not trending upward
 - o 1 less OD than the previous month
 - Very low for the population of Tioga County
 - o OD Spreadsheet will be sent via email to group

 - No word yet from OASAS
 - Asked for an extension
 - Contracted Med company not cooperating with the required information request
 - o County Attorney is involved
 - o May require litigation
 - o No information from med team in over two years

- o Red Door in Waverly in the afternoon
- o Tioga Downs in the evening
- Coalition Evaluator meeting held
 - o Using REACH (website) for data
 - o Scheduling a time for the evaluator to do a site visit
 - Probably at the end of this year or early spring
- DFC Year 6 STOP ACT Year 1 ending in September
 - Working on budgets
 - Advertising, billboards, salary & fringe
