 - Overdose deaths
 - o Funds can be spent in ten different areas
 - o Both restricted and non-restricted funds
 - A tentative plan on how the money will be spent needs to be submitted
- OASAS Grant
 - o Received \$89,000
 - o Money will be spent on:
 - In-community services
 - Another Peer Advocate
 - Two vehicles
- Governors Announcement
 - o \$1 Billion added to the budget for services
- County Plan
 - o Will be starting as soon as the new version is released
 - o Plan is due to the state in May 2023
